

Where is the International Anthony Burgess Foundation located?

The Foundation and the Engine House are located at Chorlton Mill, 3 Cambridge Street, Manchester, M1 5BY. Head south down Oxford Road from Piccadilly Rail Station towards the universities or jump on the number 85, 86 or 250 from Piccadilly Bus Station. Cambridge Street runs parallel to Oxford Road and is located behind Oxford Road Rail Station.

We have no parking spaces available at our building, but there is limited on-street parking outside on Cambridge Street. There are also open-air car parks located opposite our building and a short walk away on Oxford Road/Charles Street. Ground-level load-in is available beside the venue on Hulme Street.
